CAMU Application Status

- ◆ Draft CAMU application submitted by FMC to the Agencies March 27, 2008.
- ◆ FMC anticipates comments back from Agencies in spring 2008.
- ◆ FMC will revise draft application based on Agencies' comments and finalize for Agencies' public meeting/public comment.
- ◆ Coffee House to be held May 29, 2008 at 7 p.m. to discuss questions and clarify some issues about the CAMU.
- ◆ Invitations to be sent to Roy-Hart residents and VIPs.

RFI/CMS Update

- ◆ RFI Report Vol. I - Background and Related Information submitted April 30, 2008
- ◆ Schedule for remaining RFI Report volumes –
 - Vol. II (Suspected Air Deposition Area So. of Erie Canal & West of Niagara Orleans County Line) - August 10, 2008
 - Vol. IV (Culvert 105 and Flood Zone) - October 9, 2008
 - Vol. V (Tributary One and Flood Plain South of Pearson/Stone Roads) - December 8, 2008
- ◆ Schedule for other volumes to be submitted in July 2008. FMC will solicit input from the CIG and Village officials on schedule.
- ◆ CMS Work Plan submitted April 30, 2008
- ◆ Draft outline and schedule for additional sampling north of Canal & east of county line - to be submitted May 12, 2008.

Grant Applications Update

- ◆ Letter sent April 29, 2008 to Nia. Co. Center for Economic Dev. (NCCED) requesting inclusion of Norco property buildings in assessment program.
- ◆ Met May 9, 2008 with NCCED to discuss the current grant efforts and additional grants for pending projects.
- ◆ Researching 3 grants to determine applicability before scheduling meeting with NCCED to discuss.
- ◆ Meeting to be set up to discuss another submittal for round 3 of RestoreNY grants with the Empire State Development Corporation (ESDC).
- ◆ Exploring potential funding sources for various other Village projects - sewage treatment plant, safe routes to school, marina, canal walkways.
- ◆ Waiting to hear about Environmental Protection Fund application submitted in December 2007 for funding to implement building design standards for buildings in the Central Business District (CBD).
- ◆ Waiting to hear about action on application submitted

March 25, 2008 under NY Main Street grant program for various streetscape enhancements and revitalization projects in the CBD.

- ◆ \$40,000 grant awarded to Village from Sen. Maziarz for enhancement and economic development on May 6, 2008.

Water Treatment Plant Upgrades

- ◆ Implementation of upgrades (equipment including control system) 95% completed and will be featured at May 17 FMC plant Open House.

Phase 2 North Railroad Property ICM

- ◆ National Grid replaced poles in the Phase 2 ICM area during the week of April 21, 2008.
- ◆ Work to install an engineered cover over a section of the FMC-owned railroad property is scheduled for summer 2008. Estimated construction duration is approximately 4-5 weeks.

Vapor Intrusion Study - On-site

- ◆ Field sampling activities at FMC plant site completed March 25. Data expected in 6-8 weeks. (Study at Roy-Hart conducted in 2006 and 2007 showed no TCE contamination from vapor intrusion.)

Follow Up - 2007 Early Actions Project

- ◆ Trees to be planted on M. Droman Park and Coe property in spring 2008.
- ◆ FMC is monitoring property conditions during spring months until landscaping and lawns are re-established.
- ◆ FMC submitted draft construction report (with several actions still to be performed) on May 9, 2008.
- ◆ FMC expects the Agencies will send letters to the owners of properties remediated in 2007 similar to those sent to owners of 14 residential properties FMC remediated in 2003.
- ◆ Remediation of 46 & 48 Park Ave. is targeted for completion in 2008 construction season. Remediation is pending on obtaining access permission.
- ◆ FMC is evaluating possible 2008 Early Actions for Culvert 105 north of Sleeper Street.

Phytoremediation Pilot Study Update

- ◆ Soil samples from Middleport study field submitted January 10 for a Cornell University lab study. Results expected in May 2008.
- ◆ FMC anticipates a June 2008 study start date.
